150 YEARS OF CELEBRATING THE MAHATMA

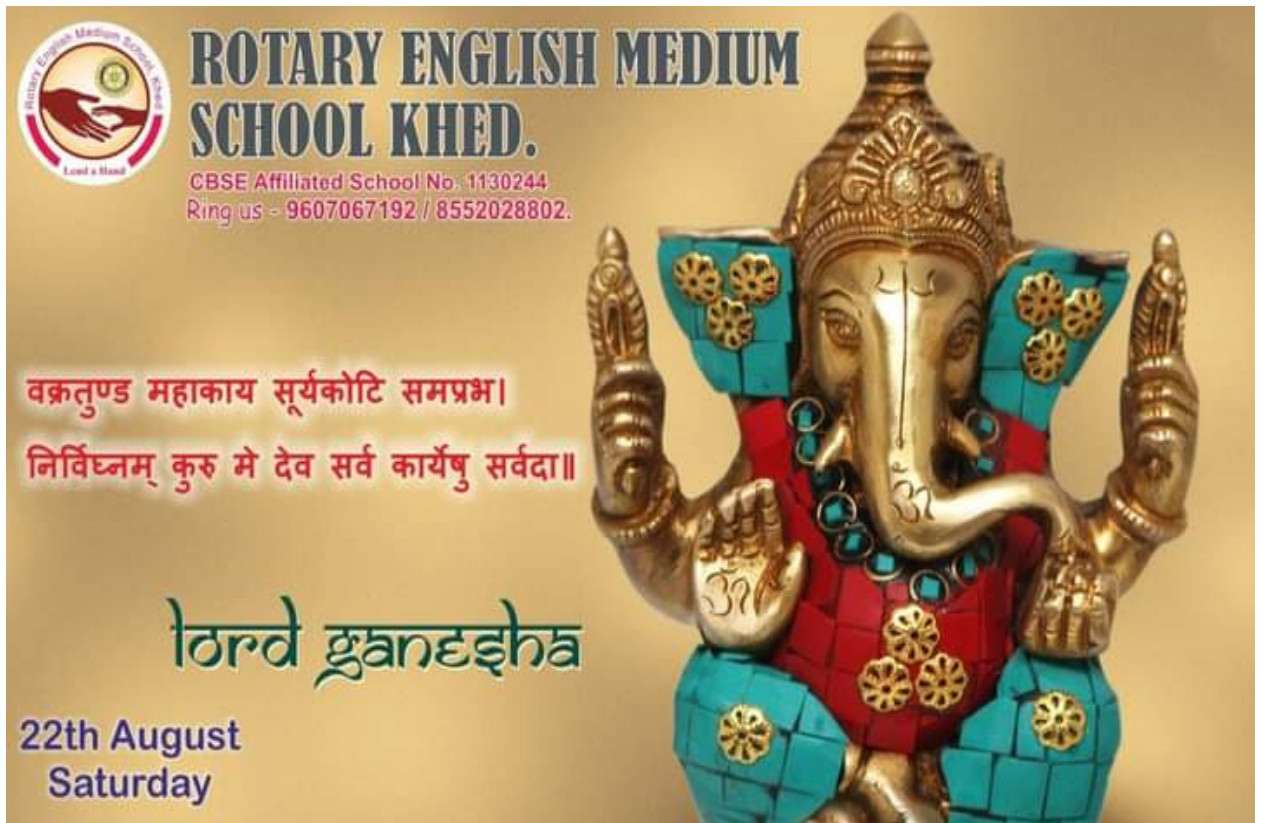

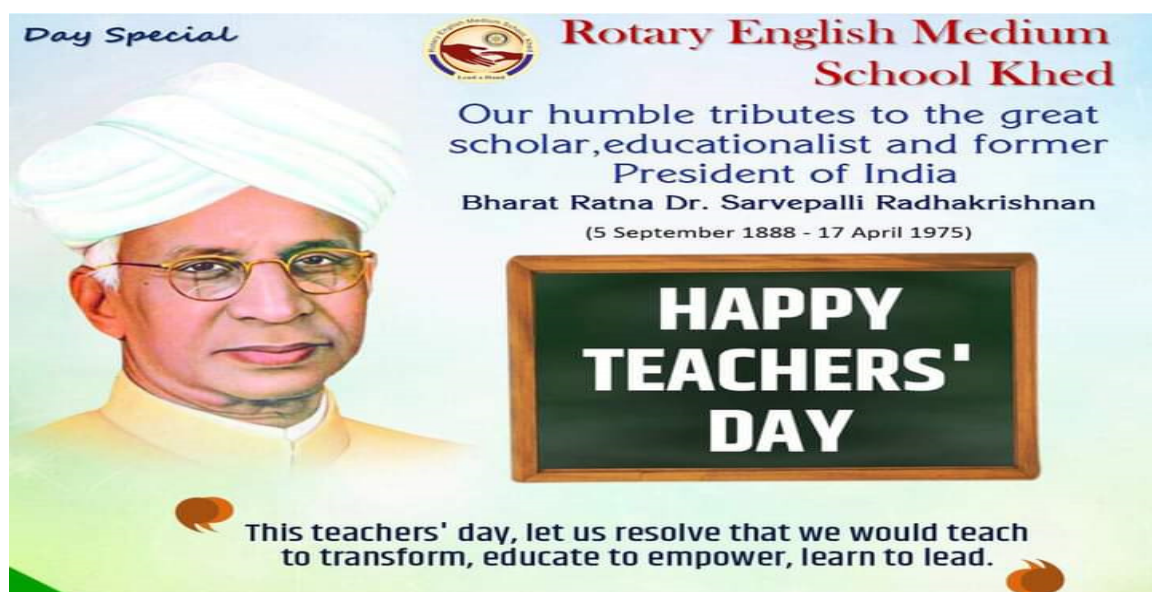


TEACHERS' DAY ONLINE CELEBRATION

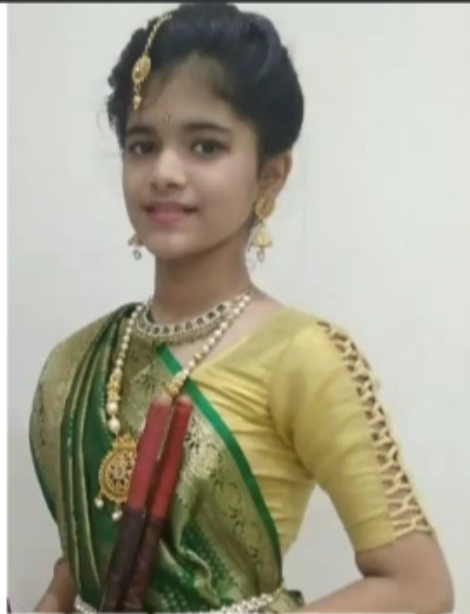


UNITY IN DIVERSITY

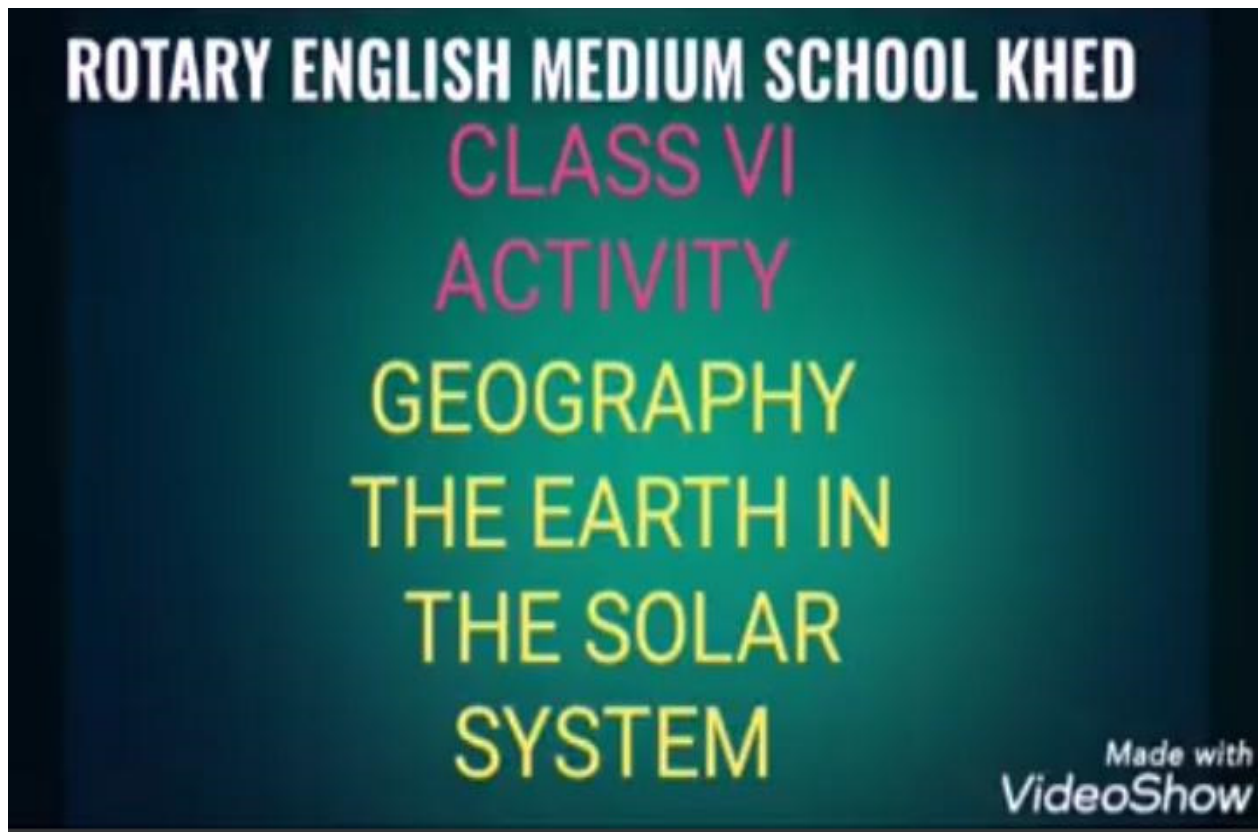

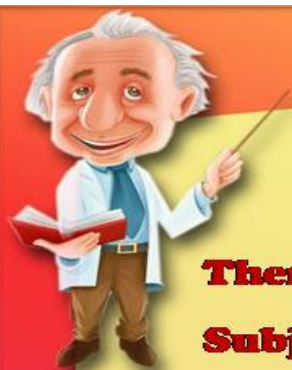
